Summary:

Margaret Richardson was born at Berwick on 4 October 1814, the second daughter of Henry and Catherine Richardson. Henry, although apprenticed as a cooper, became a successful printer and in 1808 founded the Berwick Advertiser, which he continued to run until his death in November 1823. He married Catherine Robson, a widow with a son Andrew by her first marriage, who had a grocers shop in Eastern Lane, and they had 3 children, Catherine, Margaret and Henry. Catherine married James Smail, a draper in Marygate, and Henry trained as a doctor in Edinburgh, joined the Royal Navy as a surgeon until returning to Berwick to run the Berwick Advertiser on the death of his stepbrother Andrew. Margaret did not marry and lived in Eastern Lane with her mother and stepbrother Andrew, who, on his stepfather's death, ran the paper. Andrew became ill and in 1861 he is in Rothesay, (possibly in search of a health cure) with his stepsisters, and dies in May of that year. When Dr. Henry returned to Berwick he bought 18 Castle Terrace and lived there with his sister Margaret until his own marriage to Margaret Crossman on 28 September 1869. Initially the married couple lived at Cheswick and later at Berrington. Neither however was so convenient for running the newspaper, and in 1879/80 they returned to the house in Castle Terrace and Margaret moved out to live in Ravensdowne. She was joined by her sister Catherine when James Smail died, and had various Smail nieces living with her at times. Latterly she had poor health and in Dr Henry's diaries of 1884 and 1885 he comments on going to see her nearly every day, and that her health was not very good, and in 1885 (the year he died) he thinks he will buy her a new bath chair. Margaret died on 13 April 1894.

In 1901 the house was classed as 'In Occupation' meaning it was occupied but the occupier was temporally absent.

In 1911 Catherine Robson Smail, Margaret Richardson's niece lived at number 53. Catherine Robson was the spinster daughter of James Smail, Draper, and Catherine Richardson. She died on 26 March 1918.
